## Appendix Improvements in McKownville Since 2000

- 1. McKownville Corridor Study completed, 2003
- 2. Flyover, proposed by the New York State Thruway, was stopped
- 3. McKownville Zoning Study completed
- 4. Storm water engineering study underway
- 5. New park under construction at the former McKownville Reservoir next to Stuyvesant Plaza
- 6. 1257 "Blue House" on Western torn down and land leased to McKownville Fire Department
- 7. Sidewalk completed along the west side of McKown Road from Western Avenue to the entrance of Woodscape
- 8. New sidewalk completed on Western Avenue from Schoolhouse Road to McKown Road
- 9. New sidewalk completed on Schoolhouse Road from Western Avenue to the entrance to Abele Park
- 10. New sidewalk completed on both sides of Fuller Road
- 11. "Blue House" at 1257 Western had five storm drains on or near the property that were clogged and prevented storm water from crossing under Western to the Krumkill—these were reopened by the Town Highway Department
- 12. Bus patron shelter installed at 1450 Western near Parkwood Street
- 13. Bus patron shelter installed at McKown Road and Western Avenue
- 14. Pedestrian crosswalk lights installed at Parkwood Street and Western Avenue
- 15. Pedestrian crosswalk lights installed at McKown Road, Norwood Street and Western Avenue
- 16. Improved traffic signals installed at Fuller Road and Western Avenue
- 17. Improved traffic signal lights installed at Parkwood Street and Western Avenue
- 18. Snow plowing of sidewalks improved along Western, McKown Road and Fuller Road
- 19. Trash receptacles obtained for the two new bus patron shelters
- 20. Improved traffic signal lights installed at McKown Road, Norwood Street and Western Avenue
- 21. Western Avenue stripping changed to provide a turning lane for west bound BurgerKing patrons
- 22. "Don't block the Side Road" signs installed along Fuller Road
- 23. Reconstruction of storm sewers near Fuller Road and Western Avenue to reduce frequency of Western Avenue flooding

- 24. "Don't drive on the shoulder" signs along the south side of Western Avenue installed
- 25. McKownville lighting district extended along Providence Street
- 26. Carriageway behind Norwood/Waverly streets cleared of brush
- 27. Broken storm sewer line at 1449 Western re-built by Town Highway Department
- 28. New storm sewer installed along Westlyn Place to accommodate new and older homes nearby
- 29. A new sidewalk installed by Stuyvesant Plaza from Western Avenue into the Plaza, east side
- 30. Agreement reached with the University at Albany to stop the construction of a faculty-student building at 1257 Western ("Blue House property)
- 31. The construction of a Starbucks across from the University entrance was proposed for the lot across from the University entrance and agreement was reached to locate it at the old Taco Pronto site
- 32. A farm stand operated by Jim and Cindy Barber, recruited and located behind Passonno's on McKown Road, for the summer months
- 33. The Town re-painted the old McKownville Reservoir pump house near Stuyvesant Plaza and refurbished it as a Town record storage site
- 34. Town ticketed several businesses for piling snow on the sidewalks
- 35. Town Highway department repaired storm sewers and cave-ins near several homes on Knowles Terrace
- 36. Broken storm sewer pipe at rear of 10 Parkwood Street repaired by Town Highway Department
- 37. Bridge at McKownville Reservoir Park constructed
- 38. Reached agreement with The University at Albany to plow sidewalks on Fuller near the University
- 39. Town Highway department cleaned storm sewers near Glenwood Street and near Norwood Street
- 40. Town authorized household storm sewer survey was completed and tabulated
- 41. Sound barriers approved by the New York State Thruway for property near McKown Road
- 42. Path around McKownville Reservoir Park constructed
- 43. Town appropriated \$100,000 yearly to the Town Highway Department for storm sewer repairs and maintenance
- 44. Got sidewalks cleared of overgrowth along Western Avenue
- 45. Benches installed in McKownville Reservoir Park
- 46. New sidewalks along Western Avenue, at Germano's and Days Inn, were installed
- 47. Sign post on McKown Road for Abele Park erected and path cleared and improved

- 48. New storm sewer on Providence Street constructed
- 49. Stop signs on Valley Lane installed
- 50. Town lowered speed limits on Fuller Road to 30mph
- 51. New sidewalk on west side of Elmwood Street installed—remaining section to be completed in 2014
- 52. McKownville Park approved
- 53. Sue Brown stone to be installed, 3/2016
- 54. Picnic in the Park—2014, 2015
- 55. Sidewalks installed, 2014, 2015 ON BOTH SIDES OF Western
- 56. Grant received, \$600,000 for storm sewer, NYState
