Dear Mr. Robinson:

This is in reference to your requests for signals on Route US 20 at one or more locations between the Albany City line and Fuller Road in McKownville, and at Johnston Road in Westmere, and for a reduction in speed limits on Route US 20.

These matters were considered by the Traffic Commission at its recent meeting. The Commission determined that conditions do not warrant signals in McKownville, and that the current speed limits between Albany and McCormack's Corners should be retained.

The intersection with Johnston Road was retained under study, and we will advise you when such study has been completed.


