Neighborhood Updates:

1211 Western Avenue, Albany: GSX Ventures is back before the Albany City Planning Board with a revised proposal that includes the demolition of the Sage Engineering building and construction of a 137 unit, 5 story apartment building with a parking garage and retail and office space. The total size of the building is approximately the same as dormitory that GSX formerly proposed for the site. If approved, there will be a mix of one, two and three bedroom units.
