At our September meeting guest speaker Jeremy Smith, Director of Facilities for the Capital District Transportation Authority, will tell us about the construction of the BusPlus Purple Line that is going to run through the Harriman and UAlbany campuses, and answer questions from the audience. Additionally, Town Supervisor Peter Barber will tell us about many activities that the Town is working on, including capital projects, the preliminary 2023 Town Budget, the proposed Tree Preservation Committee, a new Conservation Easement Program, and updates on Costco and the Guilderland Comprehensive Plan. Finally, Biagio DelVillano from Delaware Engineering will again update us on the status of the storm water drainage improvement project.
