## Other news:

Spring brings a plethora of activities and volunteer opportunities for Guilderland residents to accomplish tasks at home and to beautify our town. A few of these, including four on April 26 alone, are described here:

**Arbor Day:** On Friday, April 25, the Department of Parks & Recreation and the Tree Preservation Committee will celebrate Arbor Day by giving away approximately 120 tree seedlings on a first come, first served basis. Proposed parking lot near the western end of Mercer Street: In response to the Full Environmental Assessment Form for NY-CREATES' proposed parking lot, the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation raised concerns similar to those submitted by the Town of Guilderland. For now, the project is on hold until a full environmental review is completed and concerns raised by involved agencies are addressed. However, we expect that NY-CREATES will be back with a revised or completely new proposal for the site and we will do our best to keep you informed. We would like to again thank our Town and NYS officials for all of their efforts in preventing the project from going forward as proposed.
