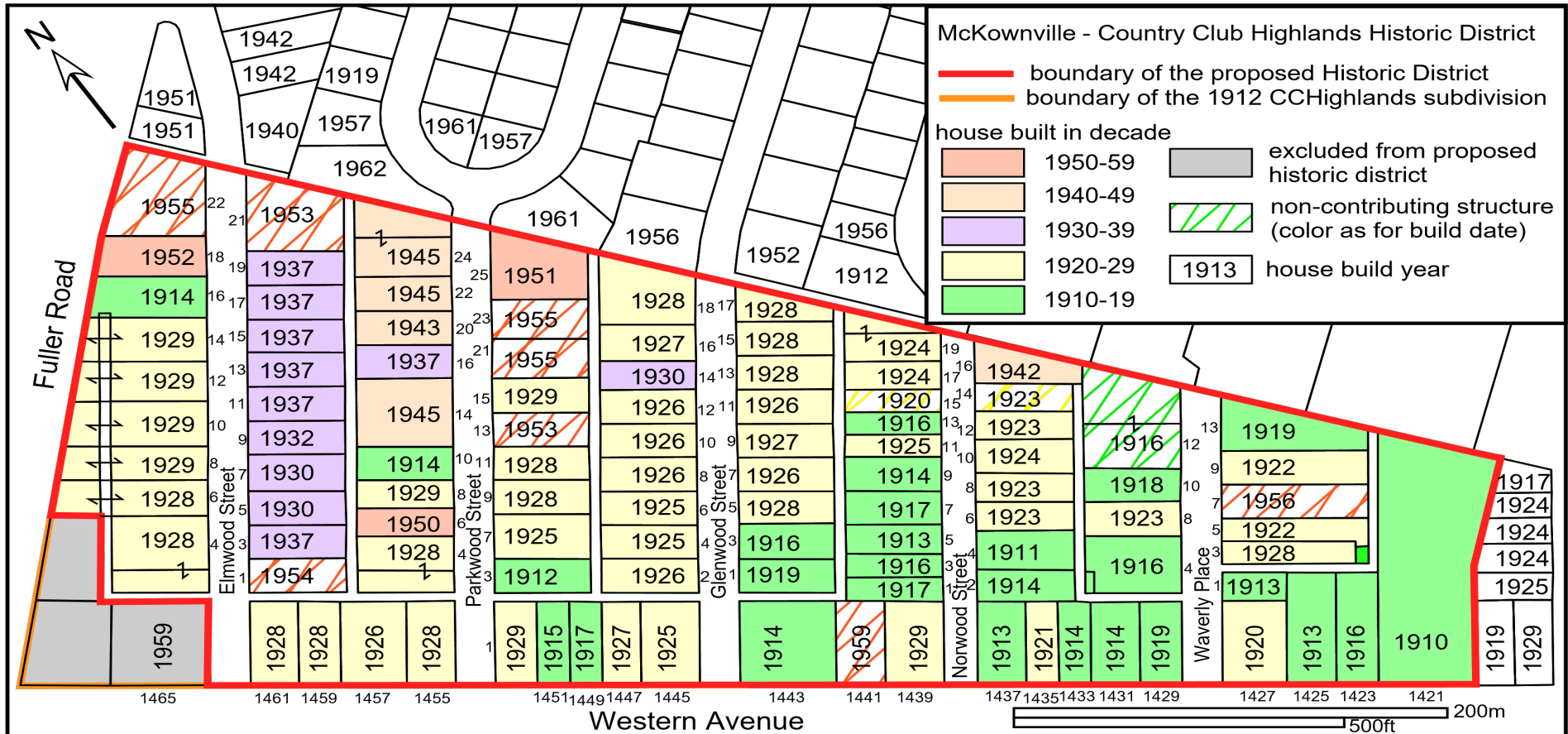

Area of McKownville included in Historic District on the National Register of Historic Places

(grey area on the corner of Western Avenue and Fuller Road excluded)



This is the area of the subdivision “Country Club Highlands” first made in 1910 by William H. Witbeck, and revised in 1912, by Arthur F. Pitkin and Benjamin F. Witbeck, to the present arrangement of streets as shown on this map.

House build dates are from combination of census (1920, 1930, 1940; NY 1915, 1925), city directory, and deed information (they are not necessarily the same as in the Town Assessor’s property records)
