These five certain lots of land situate in the said City of Albany West of Magazine Street which are known and distinguished on a map made by Overt Van Allen and filed in the Clerk's office of the City and County of Albany on the thirteenth day of September one thousand eight hundred and seventeen as Lot number Four, Fourteen, Fifteen, Twenty and Twenty one, and are bounded as follows. — The said Lot number Four is bounded on the North by Washington Street, sixteen chains twenty five links, on the East by Lot number Three, on a line parallel with Magazine Street, Seventy eight chains eighty two links, on the South by Lydius Street, sixteen chains and on the West by Lot number Five, Twenty six chains eight links, containing Forty three Acres and nine tenths of an Acre of land, and is situate Forty eight chains West of Magazine Street, The said Lots number Fourteen and Fifteen, are situate sixteen chains West of Magazine Street, and are bounded on the North by Lydius Street thirty two chains, on the East by Lot number Thirteen on a line parallel with Magazine Street, thirty three chains eighty links, on the South by the City Line and the Western Turnpike road, and on the West by Lot number Sixteen on a line parallel with Magazine Street, thirty five chains and ninety links, containing One hundred and thirteen Acres and nine tenths of an Acre of land, and the said Lots number Twenty and Twenty one, are situate about one and a half miles West of Magazine Street, and are bounded on the North by Lydius Street, thirty two chains, on the East by Lot

Acres of Land part of the aforesaid Lot number Fourteen  
and Fifteen, and which Lease expires in one thousand eight  
hundred and nineteen, and also the use of the publick  
Road or highway which intersects the said Lots, Fourteen  
Fifteen, Twenty, and Twenty one, until the said Road  
shall have been altered from being conveyed by the  
Indentures” —
