All that piece or parcel of land situate and lying in the Town of Guilderland, Albany County and State of New York and bounded upon the essessment rolls as follows: On the north by Amos Dodge, on the south by Lydius St., east by lands of Robert McCauley and west by Dennick and Longs and assessed in above named years to Aeron Hendrickson.

Also All that piece or percel of land, situate and lying in the Town of Guilderland, Albany County, State of New York and bounded on the assessment rolls as follows: On the north by Washington St., east by lot 2, south by lands of Robert McCauley and west by lands of Henry Heim, and assessed in the above named years to Lucy Dennick.

Also, All that piece or parcel of land situate and lying in the Town of Guilderland, County of Albany, State of New York and bounded as follows: North by Lydius St., east by Hendrickson south by Bloomingdale and west by Greenwald, and assessed in the above named years to Lucy Dennick.

Together with all and singular the rights, hereditaments and appurtuances to the sambelonging, or in anywise appertaining.

To Have and To Hold the above described and quit claimed premises unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, subject however to all claims the County of Albeny or State of New York may have thereon for taxes or other liens or incumbrances.
