

Harris by assignment dated February 15. 1875,
 and by said Harrison Harris assigned to Burton
 H. Demison by assignment dated March 28th 1877,
 for and in consideration of the sum of One
 Dollar to me in hand paid by Charles A. Demison
 the above named defendant I Burton H. Demison
 assignee of the above mentioned Judgment do
 hereby quit claim discharge and release unto
 said Charles A. Demison from the lien and
 incumbrance of said Judgment the following
 described lands to wit the piece of land in
 the City of Albany known as part of lot
 Number Thirteen (13) on a map of twenty seven
 lots lying North Westerly of Magazine Street
 made for the Corporation of the City of Albany
 Aug. 1. 1817. by Evert Van Alen and on file in the
 office of the Chamberlain of the said City which part
 of lot No 13 hereby released and discharged is bounded
 North by Madison Avenue (formerly Lydia's Street)
 sixteen chains. West by lot No 14 on said map
 South by Water Avenue or Turnpike 16 chains 15
 links and East by Magazine Street 29 chains 26
 links. Containing about 26 acres of land also
 that piece of land in said City described as follows
 beginning at intersection of West line of Magazine
 Street and North line of Madison Avenue, running
 thence along Madison Avenue 16 chains to South
 corner of lot No 21 on said map. then along East
 line of lot No 21 Northerly parallel with Magazine
 Street 10 chains 75 links. then parallel with Madis-
 on Avenue 16 chains to Magazine Street then South
 along Magazine Street 16 chains 75 links to the
 place of beginning containing 17 acres & 2/3 of
 an acre with the buildings & appurtenances.
 To have and to hold the said premises above described
 to said Charles A. Demison forever free clear & discharged
 from said Judgment.
