said sum of money so bid for as aforesaid having
been first duly paid by the said party of the
second part the receipt whereof is hereby ackn-
nowledged hath bargained and sold and by these
presents doth grant and convey unto the said
party of the second part All that certain farm
piece or parcel of land situate lying and being
partly in the City of Albany and partly in the Town
of Schuylersland bounded as follows
Beginning at a stake standing in the original lot
line between lots No^s 15 and 16 as laid down on a
map of 27 lots lying northwesterly of Magazine
Street made for the Corporation of the City of
Albany August 1st 1817 by Evert Van Allen and on
file in the office of the City of Albany and being
on the south side of Sydney Street which said
stake stands nine (9) chains 58 links from the south
line of Sydney Street in said lot line and runs
from thence on a line parallel with the south
