20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:

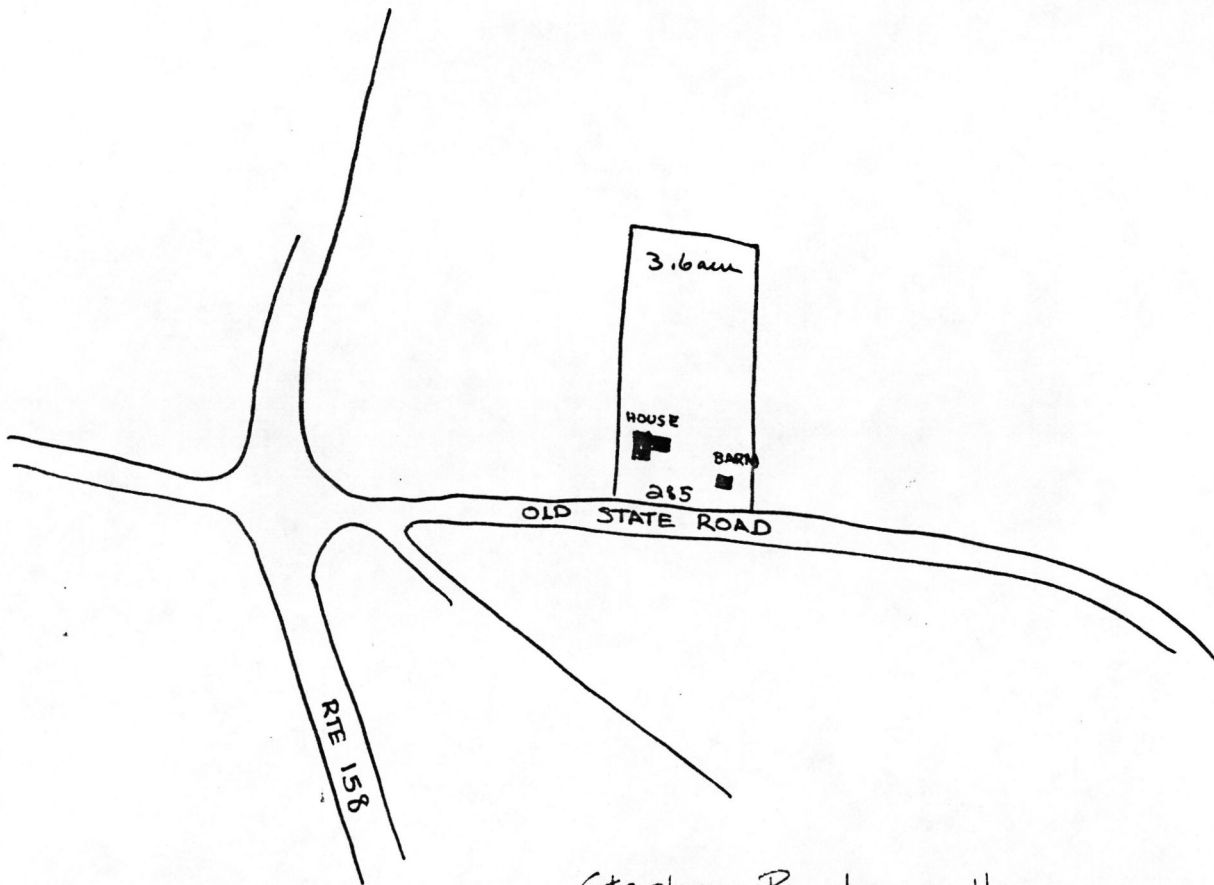
**This well-preserved 19th-century farmhouse has been in the
same family since its construction in 1864. It was built for
Stephen Pangburn, a local farmer, and is now occupied by his
great-grandson.** Details such as mitred arch window and door sur-
rounds, attic story windows, and scroll sawn brackets distinguish
the building. These and many original details on the interior sur-
vive intact. The building's continued association with descendants
of the Pangburn family and its architectural integrity contribute
to its local architectural and historical significance. Located
in an area upon which modern suburban development is encroaching,
the building stands out as a significant example of a nineteenth-
century Victorian farmhouse.

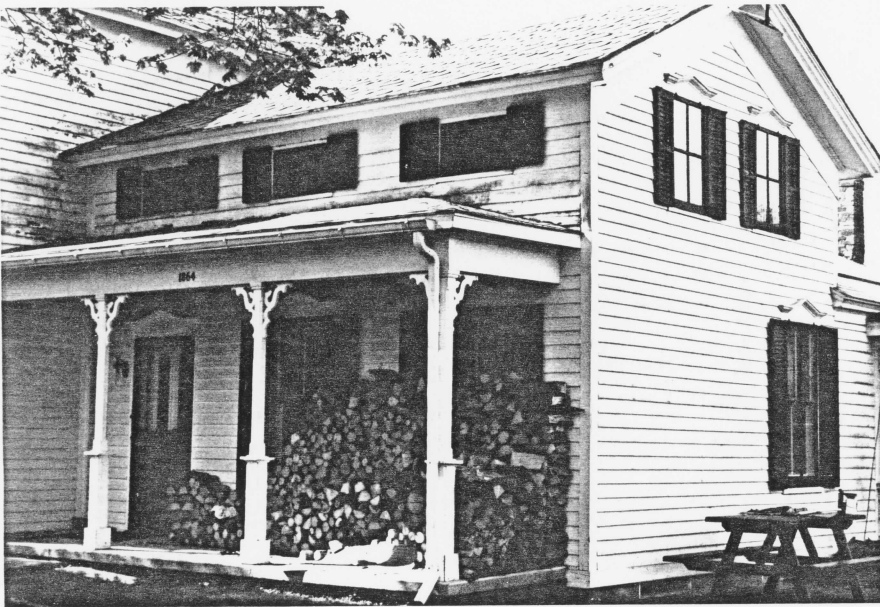

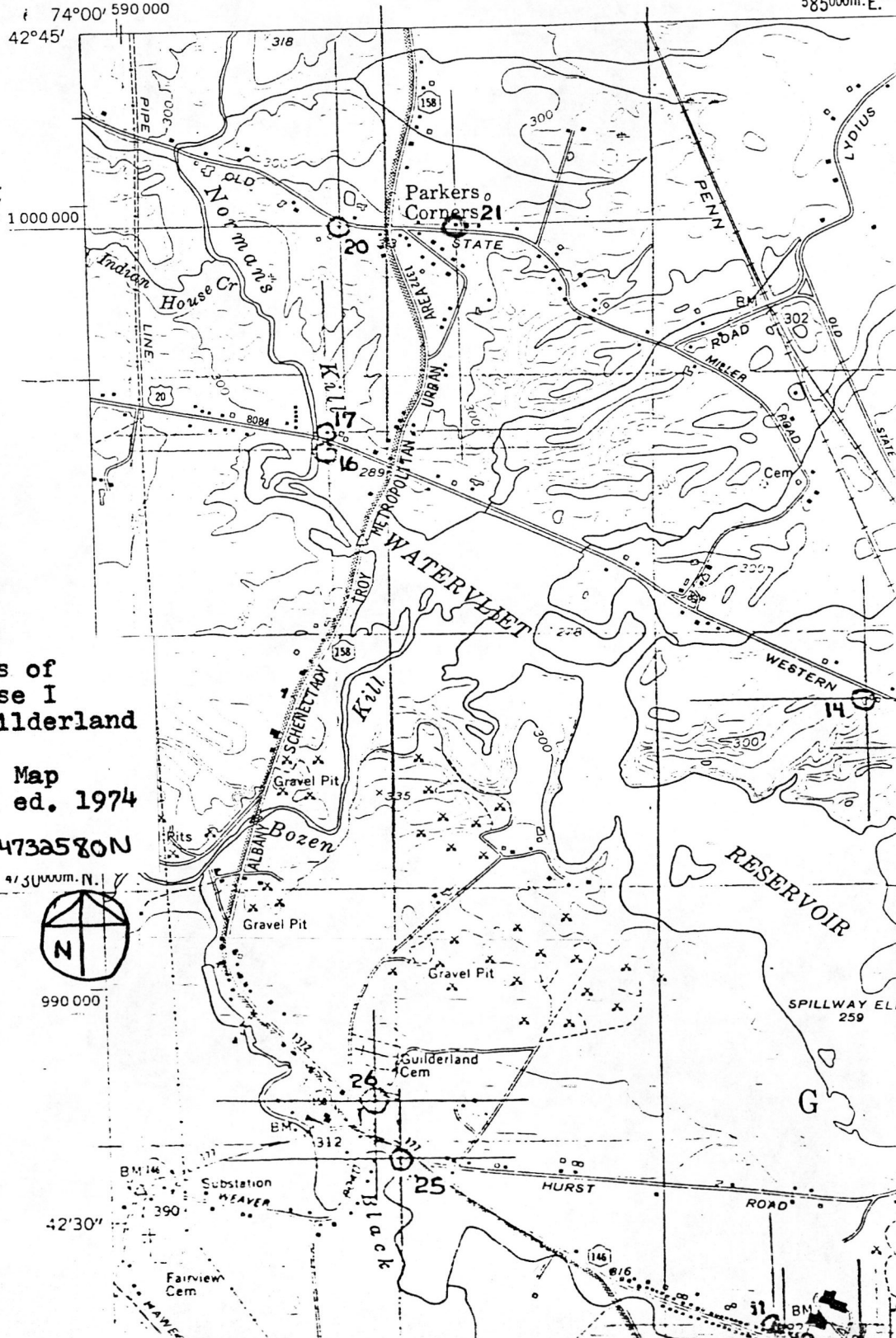
