

This Indenture, Made the 17th day of February in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and fifty four Return.

of the second part. **Witnesseth**: That, Whereas, by Chapter 908, of the Laws of 1896, known as The Tax Law, being Chapter XXIV of the General Laws of the State of New York, it was among other things enacted that "Whenever any tax charged on non-resident real estate in a county not including a portion of the forest preserve, is returned to the County Treasurer, he shall not return the same to the Comptroller, but if such tax, with interest thereon at the rate of ten per centum per annum, computed from the first day of February, after the same is levied, shall remain unpaid for six months from that date, such County Treasurer shall advertise and sell such real estate as herein provided for the payment of such tax and interest and the expense of such sale and that the expenses of publication of the notice of sale and the list of lands to be sold and the expense of conducting the sale shall be a charge on the land liable to be sold and shall be added to the tax and interest";

And **Witnesseth**, Default was made in the payment of the taxes duly and legally charged upon sundry parcels or lots of real estate, among which were the premises hereinafter described, and duly referred to the County Treasurer, with the interest thereon, which said taxes and interest had remained unpaid for six months from the first day of February, after the same were levied;

And **Witnesseth**, The Treasurer of the County of Albany, for the time being, by virtue of the power in him vested and after due notice for that purpose published and given according to law, and after a compliance with all the provisions of law by him to be performed, did sell at public auction at the Court House in the City of Albany, in said County of Albany, on the 11th day of February

in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty three each of the said parcels or lots of real estate so as aforesaid charged with taxes and interest and expenses, and remaining due and unpaid at the time of such sale,

And **Witnesseth**, Joseph Greenberg became entitled by purchase at said sale to the interest and title of the owners thereof in and to the following tract, piece or parcel of land, situated in the County of Albany and more particularly described as follows, viz.:

Now, **Witnesseth**, this Indenture Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, by virtue of the authority vested in him by law, for and in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of Eighty six and 00/100 dollars, paid to the Treasurer of the County of Albany by the said Joseph Greenberg, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and released, and by these presents, doth grant, bargain, sell, convey and release to the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, the said piece and parcel of land above described, with the hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging;

Be it further witnesseth, Hold the same to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, subject however, to all claims the County of Albany, or State of New York may have thereon for taxes or other items of impositions.

And **Witnesseth**, the Treasurer of the County of Albany, for the time being, in pursuance of the authority vested in him by law, hath thereto set his hand and affixed the seal of the office, the day and year above written.
