

THIS INDENTURE, Made the 9th day of August, in the year Nineteen Hundred and twenty-nine,  
BETWEEN Charles W. Parsons and Edith M. Parsons, his wife, and Bertrand B. Hoag and Emma M.  
Hoag, his wife, all of and residing in the Town of Guilderland, County of Albany and State  
of New York, parties of the first part, and Charles W. Parsons and Edith M. Parsons, his  
wife, both of and residing in the Town of Guilderland, County of Albany and State of New  
York, parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00)  
lawful money of the United States, and other good and valuable consideration paid by the  
parties of the second part, do hereby grant and release unto the said parties of the  
second part, their heirs and assigns forever.

All that tract or parcel of land situate in the Town of Guilderland, County of Albany and  
State of New York, known and designated as the easterly one half of lot No. Two (2) as laid  
down and represented on a map of subdivision of property belonging to the heirs of Christian  
LeGrange, deceased, made by William H. Clingerland and Son and on file in the Albany County  
Clerk's Office. Said lot is bounded and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point  
in the south east corner in the line of lands belonging to Wm. J. McKown, in 1877 and runs  
thence along the west line of lot No. Three (3) in said subdivision north forty-seven(47)  
degrees and thirty (30) minutes east thirteen (13) chains, thence north forty two (42)  
degrees and thirty (30) minutes west two (2) chains and one (1) link thence on a line  
parallel with the east line of said lot No. two (2) south forty seven (47) degrees thirty  
(30) minutes west thirteen (13) chains to the said lands belonging to Wm. J. McKown thence  
along the same south forty two (42) degrees and thirty (30) minutes east two(2) chains and  
one (1) link to the place of beginning, containing Two (2) and one hundred twenty three two  
hundredths (123/200) acres of land.

Being the easterly one half of the same premises conveyed to Charles W. Parsons and  
Bertrand B. Hoag, two of the parties of the first part by Herbert A. Parsons and Florence  
W. Parsons, his wife, by Deed dated July 28, 1914 and recorded in the Albany County Clerk's  
Office August 4, 1914 in Book No. 630 of Deeds at page 17d, excepting and reserving a strip  
of land Twelve (12) feet wide on the south end of the said lot adjoining the said lands of  
Wm. J. McKown for road or highway for the use and benefit of subdivision lots No's. 1, 3, 4, 5,  
6, 7 and 8 of the whole lots of Christian LeGrange, deceased.

TOGETHER with the appurtenances and all the estate and rights of the parties of the first  
part in and to the said premises.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above granted premises, unto the said parties of the second part,  
their heirs and assigns forever.

AND the said parties of the first part, do covenant with the said parties of the second  
part as follows:

First. That the parties of the second part shall quietly enjoy the said premises.  
Second. That the said Charles W. Parsons and Bertrand B. Hoag, parties of the first part  
will for ever WARRANT the title to said premises.

IN CONSIDERATION of One Dollar (\$1.00) - and other good and valuable considerations paid by New York Power and Light Corporation, a domestic corporation having its principal office, in the City of Albany, County of Albany, New York, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we, the undersigned do hereby severally grant and convey unto said New York Power and Light Corporation, its successors and assigns, the right to enter upon premises situate in the Town of Guilderland County of Albany, New York, owned by each of us respectively or in which any of us have an interest or upon the highway adjacent to said premises, and place, maintain, repair and replace poles, guy, guy stubs, cross arms, wires and appurtenances at any time necessary for the transmission and distribution of electricity upon and beyond our premises, the course of said line ( except laterals for house service) being approximately shown on the annexed sketch, together with the right at all times to cut, trim and remove such trees as may in the opinion of said New York Power and Light Corporation, its successors or assigns, be necessary for the proper and efficient operation thereof.
