their heirs and assigns forever, all THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, together with any buildings and improvements thereon situate in the Town of Guilderland, County of Albany and State of New York, a strip of land commonly referred to and known as the easterly five feet of lot 51 on a certain plan of Lots "Country Club Highland" situate in the Town of Guilderland, County of Albany, State of New York, surveyed for Arthur F. Pitkin and Benjamin F. Witbeck, by Leslie Allen, County of Albany, in the State of New York, as revised map of "Country Club Highlands" more particularly bounded and described as follows:
