Pond / Park Action Committee Minutes of 7 July Meeting

(Note: This meeting agenda outline was set up to mimic a Dave Letterman "Top 10" list; it's far from a "cast in stone" list.)

Location: McKownville Reservoir 7PM-8:30PM

Attending: J. Esler, W. Haldeman, M. Harauz, D. Knight (and son), A. Torda.

We inspected the inside of the filter bldg, walked around the reservoir and then discussed the following agenda items and ideas

- 10. Impact of future Executive Park Development: Comments:
 - 1 McKIA should be an official party of concern for any proposed Exec Park / Stuyv Plaza changes.
 - 2 Is there a proposal to sell a part of the old McK W Dist property to SP?
- 9. Impact of increased stormwater flow on downstream drainage structures:
 - Noted that the 36" culvert in back of the BK is still a bottleneck.
 - Noted that the culverts under Ayre Drive and McKown Rd look to be real bottlenecks.
- 8. Future use of filter/pump station building:
 - 4 Chamber of Commerce no longer uses bldg.
 - 5 Town is exploring ideas for possible future use of bldg.
- 7. How to improve the reservoir water quality:
 - 6 Review water quality questions with an expert.
 - 7 Recommended that we sample inlet and outlet to determine what the present water quality is.
 - 8 Noted a sewage smell at the culvert flowing into the pond.
- 6. How to improve the reservoir's appearance:
 - Noted that the Town has done a wonderful job cleaning up the brush around the SP end of the reservoir. (We held off recommending more clearing.) The pond is finally visible to passersby!
 - Noted with approval that the Town is now keeping the reservoir filled, rather than partly dewatered.
 - 11 Cutting the weeds on the path behind the old Roberts Realty bldg would allow strollers to walk on the path.
 - 12 It looks like there could be a nice path al the way around the pond... but care should be taken not to disturb wildlife.
 - The grounds of the property would make an nice park!

- 5. How to control storm water flow w/o losing use of the reservoir:
 - 14 Consider a berm (a mound of dirt fill) along the spillway end of the reservoir. This could markedly increase the flood storage capacity w/o pre-draining the pond.
 - 15 Consider changing the opening of the grating at the spillway to reduce clogging due to floating sticks, etc.
- 4. Effectiveness of upstream drainage basins (re silt and flow release rate):
 - 16 Investigate the design and maintenance of the Crossgates
 Detention Basin #1 to see if it's functioning properly (re silt and rate
 of release).
- 3. How much KcKlA Water District property is still owned by the Town?Status of leases?
 - We should see the original deed/boundaries of the original Water Dist. Property.
 - 18 Check location of SP Western Ave. entrance re WD property.
 - 19 Check location of SP dumpster storage re northerly boundary.
 - 20 Check status of property used by Exec Park for parking.
- 2. Increasing community awareness:
 - 21 Consider a presentation of pond/park vision to Kiwanis.
 - 22 Have a "name the park" contest.
 - 23 Construct portions of a boardwalk around part of the pond.
 - A questionnaire/mailer re the pond/park is in the final stages of development; should be ready for review this week.
- 1. Maintenance of the reservoir as a scenic pond / park:
