### Topic: The Shabbos House

A new Shabbos House is proposed to be constructed at 320 Fuller Road. It would consist of a 10,000 square feet building on two floors and a 5,000 square feet basement. This is unacceptable to the neighborhood and to all of McKownville—and more than likely—to all of Guilderland.

It is too large. It is not a residence but it is on a residential block. It is a university building that should be located on the University campus. It is for Jewish students at the University just like the Chapel House is for Christian students at the University and a Newman Center is for Catholic students. The University helped the Chapel House find a building site away from McKownville residences. The University can do the same for the Shabbos House.

What to do to stop this construction in our neighborhood?

The neighborhood presented a petition to the Town Zoning Board indicating their opposition. Many neighbors spoke out against the Shabbos House construction at the zoning board meeting. What to do next?????
