Supervisor Runion received from the Thruway Authority a summary of the hearings that were held and that many of us attended--he shared this with me--it is available on the Thruway web page--it essentially says that the widening of the section of the Thruway from Exit 23 to Exit 24 is proceeding into the EIS phase. Nothing about the flyover.
