The McKownville Farm Stand is back for another year of glorious eating.

Jim and Cindy Barber's farm stand in McKownville will open for the season on Thursday July 5, 2007--that is this week--at 12 noon and will remain open until 5:30 pm. The location is the same as last year--on McKown Road just off Western Avenue and next to the Passonno Paint Store. The Thursday date is TENTATIVE---if there is a severe thunderstorm on Thursday, as forecast, the stand will not open until Friday July 6.

After Thursday the hours and days of operation this year will be Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, 12 noon until 5:30 pm. On Saturday the farm stand will be open from 9 until 1 pm. The end of the season of operations will be in September, a week or so after Labor Day.
