SIDEWALKS

Construction has begun on the first of three sidewalk and pedestrian safety projects scheduled for completion this fall. A sidewalk is currently being laid along McKown Road from Woodscape Drive to Western Avenue. When that sidewalk is complete, intersection enhancements, including high-visibility crosswalks and pedestrian-activated signals, will be placed at the intersections of Western Avenue and McKown Road and Western Avenue and Parkwood Street, along with the addition of a sidewalk in front of 1450 Western Avenue. A bus shelter will also be added at the McKown Road intersection. Finally, a sidewalk will be laid on the east side of Carman Road to fill in the gaps in the existing sidewalk between Lone Pine Road and Coons Road.



The new sidewalks will be a welcome addition in areas where they will represent a significant enhancement to pedestrian safety. The sidewalk construction on McKown and Carman Roads is funded in part with funds received from the "Spot Grant" program administered by the Capital District Transportation Commission. The pedestrian safety enhancements at the Western Avenue intersections with McKown Road and Parkwood Street are funded primarily through a Multimodal Program grant secured for Guilderland by Assemblyman John McEneny.
