

Thank you for taking this meeting.

I would not be surprised if this conflict with Stuyvesant has been somewhat irritating to you and for that, I wish to apologize.

I have tried to keep the criticism focused on Stuyvesant Plaza but it may not have been successful.

In the next few days, I will be sending you—not the Town Board--- a letter asking that all the Stuyvesant easements be re-examined. I think they are terribly flawed.

The Association thought that there would be a public discussion of the recent easement and that a referendum could be asked for. We certainly expected to win the referendum. It is still our hope to have a referendum, if that is possible.

I think that many in McKownville thought the reservoir and park would eventually look like a smaller version of Buckingham pond and park in Albany. It is still the hope.
