Martha, I will repeat what I have told you on previous occasions. There is no vendor. The Town has never had banners of this nature manufactured.

I met with Don Reeb yesterday. We discussed the location of the signs. Don informs me that the Association will, over the course of the next couple of weeks, come up with a proposed design and a proposed list of locations for the banners. The Town will also deal with the Department of Transportation on placing banners on a state road, and with the utility companies on placing the banners on poles owned by the utility companies.

When the Association gives the design and the number of banners to the Town, the Town will identify a company to produce the banners, and Town staff will affix the banners to the poles in the locations determined by the Association.

This is the approach to this project that was approved by Supervisor Runion and by Dr. Reeb in his capacity as head of the Improvement Association, and it is the way that we intend to proceed.

Supervisor Runion has told me he's willing to be flexible (within reason, of course) on the size of the banners, and we would therefore like some feedback from the neighborhood on the matter of size.

We don't have anyone that we usually contract with for this type of work, since we have never done banners of this nature anywhere in Town in the past. The Village of Altamont has done some, and the Village Trustee who handled obtaining those banners has just provided me with the name of the vendor that they used. The firm that does most of the Town's printing work has indicated that they can provide me with a couple of names as well, so once the neighborhood is closer to being "of one mind" on the size and appearance, I can contact prospective vendors for pricing. I'd suggest starting with looking at something that would be either 24" X 60" or 30" X 60", as these appear to be rather common sizes for banners of this nature.

I like the idea of a design contest. As a resident, I will plan on entering.
