The following report was given by the chairman of the committee for the relief of the family of W.F. Roehr.

Everybody turned out nobly, several articles of furniture and clothing were collected, and \$ 69.00 in cash.

It is the opinion of the committee that there will be ample provision for Mr Roehr's family during the winter.
