

Nov. 16, 1931

Meeting called to order at 8:15 at schoolhouse
The roll call and reading of the minutes of the
previous meeting were dispensed with.

STREET AND ROADS COMMITTEE (a special temporary
committee to confer with Town Board previous to election)
John Feldman reporting. They state that the various
streets of the town are properly shown on maps
filed at the County Court House. The committee called
on Judge Johnson our representative on the
Town Board and the board agreed to care
for our streets.

The committee was given a unanimous vote of thanks
Mr. Cuklin moved that the association demand
that the Town Board care for the streets where
they were properly filed.

Water Committee's report, Mr. Gossett. The state can
do nothing so long as the chlorine content
is maintained. Dr. Barrett, health officer, is
continually testing the water and states that
it is perfectly safe to drink.

The committee suggests that a water district
be formed.

Report accepted and filed.

The President instructed the ^{Water} committee
to confer with the City of Albany to ascertain
their attitude on supplying water

SIDEWALK AND STREET COMMITTEE, MR. SANDERS

A petition be circulated to determine the
feeling of community on building of sidewalks
along Western Ave and then carrying petition
to the Town Board. The law provides that
the Town bears 35% of the expense and
the County 65%.

MOVED, SECONDED, PASSED. Refer matter to attorney
