Gentlemen:

As outlined to you at our conference last evening, the Pitkin-Witbeck Realty Company proposes to extend the present 4" main from its present terminus at Waverly Place, along Western Avenue, east so as to connect with the present branches crossing Western Avenue and supplying the houses on the South side of Western Avenue. This extension should entirely eliminate any unsatisfactory pressure conditions to which several users have complained.

In reply to an inquiry made by your committee regarding the installation of hydrants, would say that we shall be glad to install hydrants in said extension if the water district will furnish the hydrants and we shall make no annual charge for this service such as is usually charged by water companies.

The proposed extension will be started as soon as the material can be delivered. We take this opportunity of assuring your organization of our desire to cooperate with you in every way and to thank your committee for the consolatory spirit in which the whole matter has been handled.
