Third written report of Streets. Sidewalk & Street Sign Committee.

Following the last regular meeting of McKownville Improvement Assn. this committee asked a contractor, who is one of our residents, to give us the approximate cost of a five foot sidewalk, four inches in thickness, to be placed on the North side of Western Ave. from Knowles Terrace to and connecting with the Albany City sidewalk at Albany County Club entrance, a distance of 1120 feet. There is considerable filling to be done in addition to the sidewalk cost.and including this filling the approximate cost would be between \$1400.00 and \$1600.dollars. This sidewalk to be placed about 10 feet from the north side of present concrete of state highway, and could be so placed without destroying any of the trees - however, a few evergreen trees would have to be moved further back from highway, the moving of which would have to be done by owner, these trees now being on State owned land, and directly where the sidewalk would be placed.

It is the opinion of the Committee that the North side of the state highway is the logical location for a sidewalk. inasmuch as the present sidewalk is wholly on the North side from Fuller Road east to Knowles Terrace, furthermore, the state highway department are very definitely decided that they will not widen the state highway on the North side and it is rather indefinite just where a sidewalk could be placed on the South side.
