President Feldman brought a sample street sign estimated to cost about 18.00 each in place.

The transportation Comm reported an interview with the traction Co officials - who had promised to look into possibilities for all night service and other changes the comm. presented for consideration.

Mr Feldman presented Mr Doppert from the state B. of H. who gave a very instructive discussion of the various steps and conditions governing

the formation and organization of water and sewer districts in suburban communities and the benefits and advantage to be derived from such local arrangements. He also outlined some of the possible ways for improving the quantity and quality of water for this district, also methods of raising funds for such improvements.

After discussion a vote of thanks was extended to Mr Doppert and on motion duly carried the meeting adjourned.
