

May 1933

The Annual meeting of the Asso. was held in the Fire Company Rm Tues Eve May 16 '33 at 8 pm

The meeting was called to order by Pres Feldman with 28 members present.

The minutes of the April meeting were read and approved.

President Feldman presented a written report covering the principal results of the Association's activities for the year, mentioning the work of each committee

Mr Conklin reported what had been done to carry out the resolutions adopted at the April meeting for building a sidewalk on the north side of Western ave, and that the Highway Dept was revising the plans for repaving Western ave and no definite plan could be worked out until the state plans are decided upon.

Moved and carried that the original motion be amended to make the widening of Western ave pavement on the south side only of the present paving and be accounted for by a tax payers petition with as many signers as possible.

The Treasurer reported 159.76

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on hand.

Mr Jenkins reported for the Water Committee that the supply of water seemed to be diminishing rapidly and that the P.S.C. had issued a warrant for a public hearing 10:30 am. May 18th, and urged all who could do so to attend the hearing.

The water Committee by resolution was appointed the official representative of the Association for this hearing.

Mrs Gannon for the Entertainment Comm. reported the net profit of the party \$76, \$79.75. and a vote of thanks was extended to Mr Ammenheuser for paying the cost of the Hall for the evening of \$76.

The nominating committee reported in favor of re-electing the President Vice Pres Treas and secretary on motion duly carried they were on one ballot elected to serve until the next meeting 1934.

The Committee presented five names for directors, three to be elected to serve 3 years

Mr Docket and Mr Youken named Tellers. The tellers reported 28 votes for James Ammenheuser, 27 votes for

W. F. Gannon and 22 votes for
H. E. Vedder and they were
declared elected directors for
Three years.

Mr R. Fookett and Mr H. E.
Vedder were named a committee
to arrange for a playground
for use of the children of our
community.

Mr Seim for the Transportation
Committee reported that for a
time the Traction Co would have
a bus leave Orange st at
6:08 p.m. instead of 6:20
