Special meeting June 11th at Mr. Feldman's house.  
Purpose- to discuss what may be done to satisfy complaint made to the Board of Health concerning sewage disposal.

Complaint was made about the open sewer now going thru property of Mr. Ziehm. The Town of Guilderland refuses to furnish further tile for use of McKownville residents. Dr. Barrett met with Mr. Feldman, Mr. Weiler, Mr. Jenkins and Mr. Foskett and informed them that the State Board of Health contends that the responsibility rests upon the residents of the locality which uses the sewer. That if not properly taken care of in the matter of extention it will be necessary for them to demand that all sewers be disconnected, or an adequate disposal plant be installed.

Discussion revealed the fact that there would be needed 350 feet of drain tile at .90cts per foot and the cost of laying tile would be \$100.00.

That there are approximately 150 home owners immediately affected and the cost to each would be probably not more than \$3.00/

Motion was made and carried that a petition be circulated to acquaint the people concerned with the facts and the alternative in event the efforts of the Improvement Association fail. Also that personal calls be made by the directors on each and every home owner to impress him with the necessity for immediate action.
