

The regular meeting of the McKownville Impr. Ass'n was held at the Firemen's hall June 19th, 1934, Mr. Feldman presiding.

The usual reading of the minutes of the previous meeting and reports followed.

New members proposed were Mr. J. Ronan of Knowles Terrace and Mr. Wallace Brown, also of Knowles Terr.

New members accepted were Mr. Weigmann, Mr. Strober and Mr. Bowdish.

The main discussion of the evening was that concerning the complaints made about the sewage disposal and what might be done to satisfy such complaints. The motion was made and seconded that a each home owner in the districts concerned be assessed \$3.50., that a receipt for same should be issued and the money turned over to the treasury. That when the required fund was collected the committee in charge have power to proceed with the work of enclosing ~~the~~ and extending the open streams set forth in the complaint.

Discussion arose also concerning the same sewerage conditions adjoining Mr. Hurley's property and it was decided that \$50.00 (which was in reality in excess of the amount originally decided upon for the work) would take care of this objectionable feature.

A new sign ^{plate} for Norwood St. was requested and motion made that it be ordered.
