It was agreed that work should be started on the
sewer as soon as possible so that it would be

completed before the cold weather sets in.

Statement was made that Mr. Blessing would purchase the tile in carload lot, 12" tile being .4185 and 18" tile being $77\frac{1}{2}$ cts per foot., plus fee for cartage

It was decided to call a special meeting Tuesday, July 24th, at 8 PM to enable members of the committee to make a full report of moneys collected by that time so that the order for the tile might be sent in, it being the consensus of opinion that the money be collected before the tile be ordered. The names of

Mr. H.W. Best, Mr. T. Woods and Mrs. Isabel Tracey were proposed for membership.

Suggestion was made that cards be mailed to each member for each regular or special meeting. Mr. Yonkers offered the use of his addressograph for the purpose of printing the cards and motion was made & seconded that enough money be taken from the treasury for the plates.

Mr. Conklin reported that the new McKownville signs are temporary ones to be replaced soon with metal ones. It was agreed to place the upper sign at the Church Road intersection rather than at the Schoolhouse Road where it was first placed.

It was reported that most of the street signs had been painted. Also that Mr. Roche had donated \$80.00 toward building fences, backstops & for other equipment of the baseball field.

It was announced that on ~~the~~ Saturday, July 14th

the taxpayers had voted in favor of erecting a fire house which is to be built by the Fall and in which future meetings of the Improvement Ass'n will be held.
