Re the speeding traffic thru the highway from the city line west, Mr. Feldman said that the net result to date was a visit from the State Troopers who said that considering the territory covered and the relatively small number of troopers, that they were doing the best they could.

Motion was made that a committee of four be appointed to see that the snow was removed from the sidewalks by the property owners in due time.

Due to the question of sid ewalk ownership Mr. Conklin was appointed to interview the Town Board relative to this matter.

The matter of more adequate lighting of the side streets was discussed again but not acted upon definitely.
