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Once again it is time for the annual meeting of your Association. As in the past, the business of the meeting will be concerned with a review of the activities of the past year and the election of Officers and Directors for the coming year. Won't you please show your support of the Association by attending this important meeting and paying your annual dues of only \$1.00 for the year 1962-1963 so that the work of the Association may continue without interruption.

The Association has as its primary objective the mission of investigating and evaluating matters of primary concern to our district, of calling such matters to the attention of the community when this is pertinent, and of assisting then, directly or indirectly, in the procurement of necessary improvements for the convenience, comfort and healthy growth of our area.

This year we have been concerned with the possibility of the sale of approximately one and one half acres of land, presently owned by the Water District, to Stuyvesant Plaza, Inc., for the purpose of further expansion of the shopping center. After considerable discussion by the Board of Directors a recommendation was made to the Town Board that the sale of this land be investigated and that, if the present water supply would not be adversely affected, such sale should be made, the proceeds of which should be used to improve and expand the present water system. A public hearing on this matter has been scheduled for Tuesday evening, May 15, 1962, at 7:30 P. M. at the McKownville Fire Hall, immediately prior to our annual meeting. Your Board respectfully requests your attendance at both of these important meetings.

The McKownville Improvement Association is your Association, working constantly in your behalf to make our community a better place in which to live, work and play. The combined efforts of all residents of McKownville will assure the success of this objective.
