## Gentlemen:

It has some to our attention that the 42" storm drain pipe will now be installed over the Quadrini Motel property from his west property line to discharging in the Krumkill Stream.

We are also given information to the effect that there are sufficient funds in the Mc Kownville Sewer District account whereby it might be possible to extend this pipe line from the west side of Quadrini property to Hillcrest Avenue. Inasmuch as the Quadrini Motel development has, in effect, made a dam so that any overflow from the Hillcrest grading cannot find its way to the stream, it would seem advisable at this time to extend this pipe to Hillcrest Avenue.

As this has been a very troublesome matter which has come before the Board many times since 1956 it seems most appropriate to have at least this part of the correction made at this time.

An early acknowledgment of this would be appreciated.
