Our Fire department has received a number of violations and is now inadequate for this area. Only 6 months were given to correct this situation.

The treasure's report was submitted, various items paid for and itemized leaving the Assoc. with monies totaling \$183.16 and 67 paid up members.

Many thanks were expressed to Dorothy and Charles Manneri for all the time and work they have given the community. We will miss them very much.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
