

McKownville Group Tackle Problems

Members of the McKownville Improvement Association will hold their annual meeting to elect officers for the coming year and review matters facing the hamlet on May 18.

The meeting will be held at Christ Lutheran Church on Western Avenue and is set for 8 p. m. Hugh Prytherch, association president, has invited all residents of McKownville to attend.

Mr. Prytherch said reports will be presented by the hamlet's Water Advisory Committee under chairman Fred Abele on the addition to the infiltration plant now in construction, on the "difficulties in providing adequate fire protection, and on the Town Board's decision to sell McKownville water to the outside district of Three Hills Terrace."

"We hope all interested residents can be present and invite their views on these matters and other community problems," Mr. Prytherch said.

The meeting will also include a talk on new highway plans

for the area by Joseph W. Kelly, director of planning for the Albany District in the State Public Works Department.
