Mr. Joseph Kelly of DPH was introduced. He outlined new arterial highway plans for this vicinity. In question period, he indicated that South Side Arterial from Western Avenue to South Albany would not be started for several years.

A resolution in appreciation of the many years of service of Mrs Verla McCarville as Treasurer of the Association was passed unanimously

Mr. Fred Able reported discussions with the Town Supervisor on the possible acquisition of Church Point, particularly

to supply the Birchmont Area. This  
may improve water capacity and  
pressure losses due to the Three Hills  
Terrace arrangement.

Mr. John Havern entered a protest in  
opposition to a Town Police force  
for Guilderland.

Mr. Sharkey suggested that the Lesson take advantage of Collegen  
talent for lectures, etc.

The Treasurer's report was approved, together  
with disbursements of \$10 to Boy Scouts and  
Lutheran Church for notices and meetings.
