Dear Mr. Prytherch:

Your letter of March 1, 1966 addressed to Judge Cooke has been received at this office. Judge Cooke is now presiding at a Trial Term of Supreme Court in Ulster County.

Your letter states "until a decision of the Supreme Court is received, it was stated that the McKownville Fire Commissioners are helpless to take steps to improve fire protection". To the best of the knowledge of the undersigned there is no proceeding pending before Judge Cooke at the present time in the matter of McKownville Fire District vs. 1250 Western Corp., et al. There was a matter presented to Judge Cooke at the Special Term of the Supreme Court in Albany County on October 22, 1965, but our records indicate that an order in connection therewith was signed by Judge Cooke and mailed on October 28, 1965 to Attorney Louis Carnevale of 93 State Street, Albany 7, New York. The fact that such an order was signed and mailed indicates that there is no matter pending now in said action before Judge Cooke.
