NEBA Permit Refused By Zoning Board Of Appeals

The Guilderland Zoning Board of Appeals voted down a special use permit for a NEBA roast beef sandwich store at Schoolhouse Road and Western Avenue at a meeting last Friday night.

On a motion by member George Camino the board also voted to refuse a request for a re-hearing on the special use permit for the Heritage Village apartment development in Westmere. The attorney for the Western Pine Knolls residents who oppose the development, Patrick Ray-

mond, announced that an appeal will be made before the New York State Supreme Court on June 27 for a reversal of the decision that permits the erection of the apartments.

Lewis Swyer was granted an amendment to a special use permit for a Stuyvesant Plaza office building allowing him to install a restaurant on the premises.

Anthony Pietrosanto of Schenectady received a special use permit for a produce stand at 1709 Western Avenue.
