

McKownville Informational Meeting Set

A public informational meeting in McKownville to "let the people over there know just what we're doing," was announced Tuesday night by Guilderland Town Supervisor Carl Walters.

The meeting, scheduled for 8 p.m. Oct. 28 at the McKownville Fire House. Walters said, would be to explain the results of several special Town Board meetings on the new sewer district. At one of the meetings, Walters said, it was decided to re-advertise for bids on the pumping station, since no bids meeting state requirements were received.

IN OTHER announcements made at the meeting, Walters said the annual town budget meeting would be at 8 p.m. Nov. 5, and the bid opening for the new town hall construction would be at 2 p.m. Thursday.

In business, the board voted to impose a 30 mile an hour speed limit on the section of Church Road running from the Rotterdam Town line to Lydia Street.

Also, the board approved \$1,129 of equipment purchases for the town fire training center, and approved a new two-year contract for fire protection for the area bordering the Village of Altamont. The contract, taken out with the village, was increased from \$4,200 to \$5,400 per year.

FOLLOWING A PUBLIC hearing, at which no one spoke, the board approved the assessment rolls for the Krumkill Drainage Basin Improvement Area.
