Lighting Sought On Fuller Road

The McKownville Improvement Association has asked Albany County to install "modern street lighting" on Fuller Road, between Western Avenue and the Albany city line, or "to issue the necessary permit for this construction to the Town of Guilderland."

In a letter to Charles E. Cahill, chairman of the County Board of Supervisors, the association said the "poor lighting" on Fuller Road constituted an "accident hazard" to pedestrians.

Hugh Pryterch, president of the association, wrote, "School children from about 100 homes on Providence, Mercer and Warren Streets and large number of State University students walk along Fuller Road to and from the bus stop at Stuyves-

ans Shopping Center."

Mr. Pryterch said that if the county is "unwilling" to act, they should issue a permit to the town. "It is my understanding," he said, "the town government is prepared to act immediately."

"The McKownville Lighting District, established some years ago at the request of this association, will bear the cost if necessary," Mr. Pryterch added.
