## TOWN BOARD TRANSACTIONS; SCHEDULE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

At the November 10 Town Board meeting:

Guilderland supervisor Carl Walters announced that Westmere Water District progress was satisfactory. The distribution system is being installed according to schedule. One of the wells on the Mill Hill Fathers' property is turning out so well that a decision might be made to locate the pumping station there rather than on the site of the three original wells.

Bids for the construction of the storage tank will be opened at the Town Board meeting on December 13. Bids on the pumping station will be advertised shortly.

Mr. Walters reported that he had conferred with New York State Traffic Commission authorities about his and other requests to the Commission. The supervisor was told that traffic coming out of Willow Street did not justify a traffic light at the Western Avenue intersection. An advance green light for left turns at State Farm Road and Western Avenue was also deemed unfeasible. However, a new signal system will be installed at Fuller Road.

The local fire law was amended to conform with recent State legislation. A permit from the Town building inspector or his delegate is needed for a grass or brush fire. Agreements may be made with local fire districts to investigate and issue permits. Otherwise the law is substantially unchanged. Violations can bring fines of from \$10 to \$100.

Everett Ross was re-appointed dog enumerator for next year.
