Dear Mr. Prytherch:

Your letter dated August 18, 1967, has been referred to this office for reply.

We wish to inform you that the intersection of Route 20 with the Northway has been under study for some time. As a result of this study, the following measures will be taken as soon as possible:

1. Install "Highway Ends $\frac{1}{4}$ Mile" signs on the Northway in advance of Route 20 to replace existing "All Traffic Exit $\frac{1}{4}$ Mile" sign.
2. Replace existing 8" traffic signals indications with 12" lenses.
3. Replace existing "Traffic Signal Ahead" sign with larger size.
4. Install flashing lights on the barricades located on the left side of the Northway just in advance of Route 20.

We wish to express our appreciation for your interest in the safety of the traveling public at the above location.
