

Guilderland 11/29/67 Sewer Study Authorized

Sewers and streets were the key times on the agenda at a special meeting of the Guilderland Town Board Friday night.

The board authorized the expenditure of funds for a map, plan and report on the survey work conducted by the Standard Engineering Corp., the town's sewer consultants.

Also, approval was given for changing the name of the district involved from the McKownville Sewer District to the Krum Kill Sanitary Sewer Improvement Area. The change sets a precedent. Subsequent sewer districts will be designated by the creek or basin which would serve the area.

In other action, the board accepted several streets that will serve two proposed housing developments in the Carman Road and Lydius Streets areas.

Also considered were the plans for a private sewer district to be built by the State Farm Corp. The district would eventually serve the Heritage Village and Presidential Acres housing projects, as well as the Guilderland Middle School.
