John F. Feldman Dies, Once Town Supervisor

John F. Feldman of 10 Glenwood Street, McKownville died on August 23 at the age of eighty. He had been active in a variety of local civic organizations for over 40 years, holding responsible positions in most of them. From 1952 through 1954 he was supervisor of the Town of Guilderland.
