

TO RESIDENTS OF
MCKOWNVILLE WATER DISTRICT
REGULATIONS FOR OUTSIDE LAWN AND GARDEN SPRINKLING

EFFECTIVE MAY 15, 1970

Permitted hours for use on week days Monday through Saturday from 7 A.M. to 9 P.M. and on Sundays from 7 A.M. to 12 NOON - not to exceed three (3) hours on any one day - as outlined below:

- Section 1: These would be houses with even numbers.
viz: 2-4-6 etc.
On calendar days with even numbers, viz: 2-4-6 etc.
- Section 2: These would be houses with uneven numbers,
viz: 1-3-5 etc.
On calendar days with uneven numbers, viz: 1-3-5 etc
- A. In the event of a serious fire ALL HOSES shall be turned off immediately and for the duration of the emergency.
- B. If water conservation under these restrictions turns out to be unsatisfactory it will be necessary to revert to more stringent regulations.

The above regulations refer to lawn soakers as well as hand sprinkling or other sprinkling devices.

PRIVATE WELLS which are used for outside or other use must display a sign PRIVATE WATER readable from the roadway and have faucets permanently labeled. The Water Dept., State Farm Road (phone 456-6474), must also be notified for inspection which would verify that there is no connection with the public water supply. There are no other regulations regarding private water supply use.

THE TOWN BOARD HAS PASSED A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING ALL WATER COOLED AIR CONDITIONERS OTHER THAN THE RECIRCULATING TYPE.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ORDINANCE shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon the conviction thereof be punishable by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.00) and may also have their water service cut off.
