

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town Board of the Town of Guilderland will conduct a public hearing on September 12, 1972 at 9:15 P. M. at Guilderland Town Office, Route 20, Guilderland, N. Y. on the application of Armand Quadrini to rezone from R10 to B-1 the following described premises:

All that certain piece or parcel of land, together with the buildings thereon, situate, lying and being on the northerly side of the Great Western Turnpike, in the Town of Guilderland, Albany County and State of New York, and more particularly bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the northerly side of the Great Western Turnpike, distant 78.07 feet westerly from the southeast corner of the property now owned by Charles A. Gemlick; thence running

NORTHERLY and at right angles to said Turnpike 237 feet to a point in the south line of the Albany Country Club property; and thence

WESTERLY and along the south line of the said Albany Country Club property 90.25 feet to a point; thence

SOUTHERLY 262.50 feet to the north line of said Great Western Turnpike said line opposite the spring house on the property hereby intended to be conveyed, runs 1 foot west to the southwest corner of the spring house, said line making an interior angle in the property hereby intended to be 85 degrees and 30'; thence

EASTERLY and along the northerly side of said Turnpike 107.50 feet to the point or place of beginning.
