The Department recently met with Mr. Swyer to discuss your concern regarding the storm drainage from Stuyvesant Plaza into the McKownville Reservoir.


We went to the shopping plaza and reviewed the storm drainage system. It appears that only a portion of the shopping plaza drains into a storm sewer that flows into the McKownville Reservoir. This appears to be the area behind Executive Towers, and a small area behind the maintenance shop. This drainage flows into a storm sewer that also drains areas west and north of the plaza, including drainage from the Thruway/Northway highway systems.

Looking at the topographical features in that location, we are not sure how the water could be drained to some other area.
