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THREE ANNOUNCEMENTS  
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1. Monthly Meeting -- Meet the Candidates -- Monday October 15, 1979, at the Tom Sawyer Moter Inn, at 8:30 PM, preceeded by a business meeting and a round-up of information about Pyramid-Crossgates beginning at 8:00PM. All Town Board candidates have been invited to this meeting.
2. Town Meeting -- Tuesday October 9, 1979 at 8:00 PM at Town Hall. Please come and help us again ask Town Hall elected officers to STOP CROSSGATES. At the last Town Meeting over 180 people were there to demand that the Town Board take actions necessary: (1) to prevent the further widening of Western Avenue; (2) to change the zoning on the Pyramid-Crossgates parcel back to what 'it' was before the Town Board changed the zoning last summer; (3) to repeal 485b property tax exemption; (4) to use tax monies or state or federal monies to purchase the 16 acres of wetlands on the Crossgates-Pyramid site, therefore preventing construction of the Mall; and (5) order relevevant Town officers to testify at the upcoming hearings on the Pyramid-Crossgates shopping center to challenge the accuracy of the data which has been presented by the developers. REMEMBER -- this is the election year. We need promises and actions now, not after election day. Don't vote party -- vote the candidates -- and your presence at TOWN HALL will tell everyone that THE issue this year is PYRAMID-CROSSGATES! Also -- do not forget to vote on election day.
