

# Burger King seeks Western Avenue site

GUILDERLAND — The town Zoning Board of Appeals has scheduled a public hearing for 7:30 tonight on a request by Burger King to build a fast-food restaurant on Western Avenue.

The site would be at Fuller Road and Western Avenue, a site currently occupied by a BP gasoline station. The fast food company is proposing a facility

with 86 seats inside and 32 outside plus a drive-up window.

Burger King has an option to buy the site from Chester and Mabel King of McKownville.

A year ago, the company opened a 90-seat Burger King on Western Avenue two miles west of the current site.
