

McKownville Improvement Association Board meeting , June 15, '82

Present: Childs, Ellinwood, Witham, Reeb, Torda, Jenkins, Bailey, Behn.

1. The Board passed unanimously a resolution supporting the rezoning of ~~Tax~~ Zoning District #107 from B-1 to R-10. Don Reeb wrote up the resolution.

2. The Board endorsed the idea of more enlightened use of the 10% green space provision, eg. to support the acquisition and maintenance of a bike path from McKownx Road to the Middle School or to Tawasentha; or for walkways along streams. The Board encouraged LNC to explore this idea with Town officials.

3. The Board decided to try to put out a quarterly newsletter. The first issue would be aimed for August 1, and have an inset containing a survey and a membership application. Alice Torda would ask John Whitcraft to participate, perhaps as editor of the first issue. Included in the first issue would be articles on the neighborhood watch (Behn), history (Marey Bailey), Kevin Chhan (Esler?), census data (Reeb), finances/legal fund expenses (Witham), town issues (LNC), new residents (everyone), coming events (everyone).
